



Get On With It 2017

An opportunity to work with five local artists in their studios

ArtaRoundTown would like to invite you to this second exciting opportunity for young and curious artists, an immersive interdisciplinary experience working under the instruction and guidance of five established local artists in their personal studios. Last summer the focus was on the fine arts – painting, photography, sculpture and painting and was very successful. This time we will alternate to the applied arts modelling the concept after the art theories of the early 20th century school of design called the Bauhaus where many of the ideas for modern architecture and design were born.

Working in a small group of no more than ten and over a period of 10 weeks spanning July, August and an exhibit in September, you will work on developing your creative process, create four pieces of work in the disciplines of fiber, clay, glass and interior design, take part in a group critique of your cumulative work and develop your artist's statement. At the end of all of this there will be a group exhibition to showcase your work to friends, family and members of the public.

Requirements

- must be between the ages of 16-22
- must provide own transportation getting to and from artists' studios
- the cost of this program is \$120.00 per individual
- Participants will be expected to bring a sketchbook
- the size of this program is capped at 10

Special Note for Adult students: Although this program has been designed specifically for younger artists we know that Adults would also appreciate an opportunity to take these workshops. Ages 16-22 will have first chance at the 10 spots available and after the deadline if they have not all been filled we would gladly offer the program to adult students at a rate of \$50 per workshop or \$175 for all workshops.

Deadline for applications is June 5, 2017, keep in mind only the first ten to apply and pay in full will be accepted.
